 Higher animals such as human beings also perform anaerobic respiration. For example – When we exercise, our muscle cells perform anaerobic respiration, as oxygen is used faster and hence it gets depleted in the muscles. [1]

# It is absolutely necessary to control the fission reaction in nuclear power plant.

- Ans. 1. In nuclear power plants neutrons are bombarded on atom of Uranium 235. After each fission reaction of Uranium-235, three neutrons are released along with an energy of 200 MeV. [1]
  - These three neutrons, in turn, cause fission of three other Uranium-235 atoms, thus releasing more energy. If this chain reaction is allowed to continue, it may get out of control as energy is released very quickly which may result in a nuclear explosion. [1]

Hence, it is necessary to control the fission reaction in nuclear plants.

#### iii. Flower is structural unit of sexual reproduction in plants.

- Ans. 1. A flower contains the essential whorls, androecium and gynaecium - the male and female reproductive parts, respectively.
  [1]
  - It produces the male gametes (pollen grains) and female gametes (ovules). Fertilization takes place by the union of male and female gametes.

Hence, flower is a structural unit of sexual reproduction in plants.

**Ans.** The objectives of disaster management are:

- To reduce deaths during a disaster and to give relief to the people.

- Ans. 1. Ethanol is obtained by the fermentation of molasses. When ethanol is mixed with the petrol and diesel, it reduces the amount of fossil fuels to be used and thereby our reliance on them.
  - It reduces combustion emissions.
  - 3. It produces good amount of energy.
  - It makes the whole process of production and usage more cost-effective and lesser harmful to the environment.

#### Write Darwin's theory of natural selection.

- Ans. 1. Darwin proposed the theory of natural selection which explains the survival of the fittest. According to him, all the organisms reproduce prolifically. All the organisms compete with each other in a life-threatening manner. [1]
  - In this competition, only those organisms sustain which show the modifications essential for winning the competition. Nature selects only those organisms which are fit to live and the rest perish.
  - These sustained and selected organisms reproduce and thereby give rise to new species with their own specific characters.



Ans. When the sluice gate at point B is opened, the water from the reservoir will start flowing from point B to the turbine, the potential energy of the water from point B to the top of the water reservoir will be converted into kinetic energy. [1]

# b. What will be the effect on electricity generation, if the channel taking water to turbine starts at point A?

Ans. If the channel taking water to the turbine starts at point A, then water will flow with a greater speed. This will result in more efficient rotation of turbine and more generation of electricity. [1]

# c. What will be the effect on electricity generation, if the channel taking water to turbine starts at point C?

Ans. If the channel taking water to the turbine starts at point C, it will affect electricity generation adversely. C is on the lower height as compared to channel that carries water to the turbine.


Ans. i. Cockroach, frog, sparrow cannot regenerate its broken body part. [1]

  - From methane, methanol is obtained. Ethanol is obtained from molasses of sugarcane.


